We are writing with regard to your application for residence which was accepted for consideration on 29 November, 1999.

We are pleased to inform you that your application for a residence visa for New Zealand has been approved.

You will be issued with a residence permit on arrival in New Zealand. A residence permit entitles you to live, work and study in New Zealand. This permit expires when you leave New Zealand. A valid returning resident's visa is required to enable you to be issued with another residence permit on your return to New Zealand.

You have now been issued with a returning resident's visa. Returning resident's visas are issued for two years in the first instance. The issue of a further returning resident's visa after this time may depend on the amount of time you have spent in New Zealand during the previous two years and your tax residence status during that period. For information about obtaining a further returning resident's visa, please refer to your nearest office of the New Zealand Immigration Service.

Your passport(s) have been endorsed with a residence visa which is current for travel until 19 July, 2001. You must travel to New Zealand before that date.
