Dear Paulo Kundig

Thank you for your letter dated 1 December 2008, concerning [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

After carefully considering your submissions I have decided to grant Mr and Mrs [REDACTED] two year multiple entry visitor's visas as an exception to policy, subject to them meeting health and character requirements. This will allow Mr and Mrs [REDACTED] to live in New Zealand until they are eligible to be sponsored for residence under the Parent policy.

Mr and Mrs [REDACTED] will need to complete the appropriate form, include this letter with their application, pay the relevant fee, and lodge their application from an offshore branch within three months of the date of this letter. If the visas are issued, they will allow for permits to be granted upon arrival which will expire the day after the expiry date of the visas.
